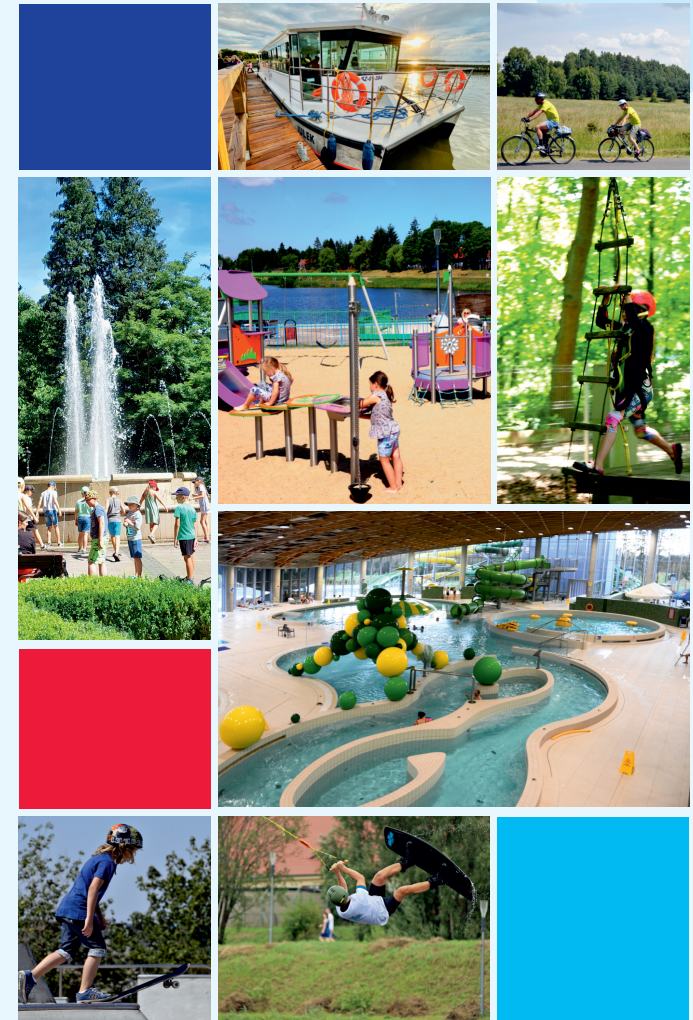
Bicycle City

Koszalin has over 100 km of bicycle paths and roads, improving and expanding the cycling infrastructure each year. An excellently developed network of bicycle routes makes it possible to reach nearly every corner of the city. The city operates a bicycle rental system - Koszaliński Rower Miejski (En- Koszalin Municipal Bicycle). koszalinskirowermiejski.pl



Water Valley

For enthusiasts of active leisure, there is a town beach with a guarded swimming area during the summer season. Wodna Dolina (Water Valley) offers a beach volleyball court, an outdoor gym, a mini golf course, and a playground. Catering and sanitary facilities as well as free parking (including for campervans) are also available. Extreme thrills are provided by the WakePark with a two-post lift, equipment rental and instructor service.



The wealth of attractions that await visitors in our city will make for unique and unforgettable moments. The tourist map of Koszalin features a whole range of locations that will allow you to spend your time actively, as well as to take a break from the hustle and bustle of big-city life.



Water Park

The region's largest and most modern Aquapark provides a variety of attractions for people of all ages. The leisure area offers six pools (including two outdoor ones) as well as a rushing river, jacuzzi and numerous slides, such as a 176 m Anaconda slide. The Water Park features sauna and spa areas, a gym and a restaurant. aquapark.koszalin.pl



Chełm Hill

A forest complex with numerous hiking and cycling paths and marked hiking trails, such as. The Pomeranian Route of St. Jacob or the Tatra Loop Trail. Góra Chełmska (Chełm Hill) is the perfect place for active outdoor recreation. On the summit is the Sanktuarium Matki Bożej Trzykroć Przedziwnej (Sanctuary of Our Lady of the Threefold Preciousness) and a 31.5 m tall observation tower. From the tower we can see the city's beautiful panorama, and the Baltic Sea in the distance. At the foot of Góra Chełmska is a Picnic Park with a barbecue area and outdoor gym, as well as a Rope Park.



Julek Ship

The cruise passes through the picturesque Jamno Lake - the third largest lake in the West Pomeranian Voivodeship. The ship Julek runs from Jamno Marina to Mielno and Unieście. It is able to accommodate 110 passengers and bicycles on board during a single course. At the marina, you can see a sculpture of Julek - the hero of a local legend about dwarves living on the banks of the Jamno River, who are a symbol of love, kindness and friendship. mzk.koszalin.pl/julek



Sports events

Throughout the year, the city organises and patrons multiple sporting events. There are numerous bicycle rallies, e.g. Velo Baltic Tour de Koszalin and running events, including marathons and half-marathons, e.g. "Nocna Ścieżka" (En- Night Racket) or "Leśna Piątka" (En- Forest Five).
